Summary

DevOps Engineer is a role I have been pursuing since I first started researching the tech industry. However, I understand that in order to improve and automate processes, it is essential that I can appreciate the complete Software Development Lifecycle (SDLC). The Software Development L4 Bootcamp has provided more knowledge regarding the SDLC, as well as Python, SQL, and Version Control. The Bootcamp also covered DevOps Essentials and Agile Fundamentals, covering topics like CI/CD pipeline and tools such as Jenkins and Docker.

Never one to shy away from a new challenge/experience, from obtaining the Gold Duke of Edinburgh's Award and working with charities to help those in need. However, it's the problem solving from years of physiotherapy placements and vivas, the idea of working through levels of difficulty trying to find a solution that will translate most effectively. I have acquired the AWS Certified Cloud practitioner, Azure Fundamentals: AZ-900 Certifications, and Terraform Associate 003. Aiming towards AWS Solutions Architect Associate exams within the next couple of months. Currently I am working on a full stack project using Next.js and Supabase, experimenting with implementing CI/CD pipeline to apply DevOps knowledge gained from QA and from DevOps Bootcamp from TechWorld With Nana.
